1. Aim

To achieve the capacity-building of young scientists who will participate actively in relevant international communities, which is one of the aims of this Global COE Program, this program will offer the following English Presentation Training Course as a support to the young researchers.

2. Intended for

-Students who are enrolled in the Global Arid Land Science (Division of International Studies on Dryland Agriculture, the Course of Bioenvironment Science), the United Graduate School of Agricultural Sciences, the Students who receive guidance from the professors who are engaged in the Global COE Program, Postdoctoral researchers and Assistant Professors of Arid Land Research Center

-Students who have adequate English proficiency for taking this class
(ex., TOEIC score is over 600 points.)

3. Capacity

Around 10

4. Period

From mid-October, 2011 to late December, 2011 (once a week, each 90 minutes)

5. Contents

It consists of lectures and practices and aims to help young researchers who have many opportunities to make presentations in English at the international conferences etc. for improving their English presentation skills.

6. Place

Arid Land Research Center, Tottori University

7. Costs

Tuition and materials costs will be covered by the Global COE Program.

8. Recruitment

Applicants should submit the Application Form. Selection will be held if the number of applicants exceeds the capacity.

9. Other

Students should attend more than seventy percent of all classes in principal.
